UPDATES:

Haley Geyer informed the Board that Public Works has resumed on grading and prepping the pickleball court project. Both lights and net/accessories were delivered this week and the goal is to get concrete poured in the month of July.

Haley Geyer added that the Mars Baseball Association will be installing lights on the Rotary Pavilion and the Township will be assisting with some of the cost of supplies and labor.

The two, new pavilions have been ordered and are estimated to begin construction in the fall of 2021. Public Works will be determining their plan to move the current Kiwanis Pavilion to it's new location near pickle ball.

DISCUSSION:

The Board discussed the Rules & Regulations for Park Items. Final changes will be made before submitting to solicitor and the Board of Supervisors for review.

Sip & Stroll is in full swing of planning. The Board is looking for volunteers to help with set-up, managing the event from 5-9 P.M. and assisting with clean-up afterwards. All volunteers will receive a t-shirt and be able to attend the event for free.

Heidi Brandon brought up new charging stations in the park. Armco Credit Union placed them in the parking lots at their new location; it would not cost the Township any funds and she will have more information in the coming weeks.

The Annual Benefit Car Cruise is set for Saturday, September 18th with a rain date of Sunday, September 19th. All proceeds and contributions will benefit the new Adams Township Police Department K-9 Program. More details to come at our next meeting.
