

The regular meeting of the Adams Township Board of Supervisors was held on August 9, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. at the Adams Township Municipal Building, 690 Valencia Road, Adams Township, Mars, PA.

Present at the meeting were Supervisors Russell R. Ford, Ronald J. Shemela, Edward L. Vogel, Linda E. Lees and Darryl M. Brandon; Solicitor Michael Gallagher, Township Manager Gary Peaco, Chief of Police Shawn Anglum, Park Director Haley Geyer and Assistant Secretary Andrea Dunton.

Chairman Ford called the meeting to order at 7:05 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

On a motion by Linda E. Lees and seconded by Edward L. Vogel, the Public Works Department Report for July was approved. All were in favor.

CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT

Release of Rental House Security Deposit

NEW BUSINESS

New Amendment to Sunshine Act

Solicitor Michael Gallagher gave an update that the new amendment for the Sunshine Act requires that meeting agendas be posted to the public 24 hours in advance to the meeting. He explained that if there are any changes/additions to the agenda after it has been posted, the Board will have to make a motion to amend the agenda and state the reasoning. He added that the Board was practicing at tonight's meeting, and this new act will go into effect next month.

On a motion by Linda E. Lees and seconded by Ronald J. Shemela, the agenda was amended to add the approval of line painting as this project needs to be completed as soon as possible.

Line Painting

On a motion by Linda E. Lees and seconded by Edward L. Vogel, the line painting contract with Alpha Space in the amount of \$17,910.00 was approved. All were in favor.

Three Degree Road Project


