

## **ADAMS TOWNSHIP PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

The regular meeting of the Adams Township Parks and Recreation Board was held on September 7, 2021. The meeting began at 7:00 P.M. The following members of the Parks and Recreation Board were present: Heidi Brandon, Kelly Cheponis, Shelley Savoroski, Tom Scheller, Rochelle Seideneck and Marilyn Watson. Also present was Parks & Recreation Director Haley Geyer.

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

On a motion made by Marilyn Watson and seconded by Heidi Brandon, the Parks and Recreation Board minutes for August 3, 2021 were approved.

Six were in favor.

### **UPDATES:**

Haley Geyer informed the Board that Public Works has resumed prepping the pickleball court project. Grading has been completed and next will be laying drainage and conduit. The plan is to have concrete poured by September.

The two, new pavilions have been ordered and are estimated to begin construction in the fall of 2021. Public Works will be prepping the current Kiwanis Pad and determining how to move the existing pavilion to its new location near pickle ball.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### Sip & Stroll Recap

The fundraiser is set for August 21, 2021. The Board is looking for volunteers to help with set-up, managing the event from 5-9 P.M. and assisting with clean-up afterwards. All volunteers will receive a t-shirt and be able to attend the event for free. The layout will take place on the access road above the T-Ball Fields; the stage will be set up in the original location, pop-up tents and garbage cans will be staggered on each side, picnic tables will be set up in the grass area and perimeter tape will be staked around the entire area.

There was a question about the number of pre-sale tickets available and it was recommended to cap it.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Benefit Car Cruise

The event is scheduled for Saturday, September 18<sup>th</sup> with a rain date of Sunday, September 19<sup>th</sup>. All proceeds and contributions will benefit the new Adams Township K-9 Officer, whom will be in attendance at the cruise. Letters have been sent out to local residents and businesses to sponsor the event by providing raffle baskets and/or door prizes. Haley Geyer reported that the goal is to have at least fifteen raffles for participants and spectators. The door prize tickets will be called out every 30 minutes (green ticket), raffle baskets (red ticket) and 50/50 (blue ticket) will be announced at the end of the event at 3:45 P.M. Zimmerman Family Farms and D's Apple Dumplings will be selling food and refreshments during the event as well.
