

ADAMS TOWNSHIP PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

The regular meeting of the Adams Township Parks and Recreation Board was held on October 6, 2020 at Adams Township Municipal Building located at 690 Valencia Road, Mars, PA.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

On a motion made by Heidi Brandon and seconded by Rochelle Seideneck, the Parks and Recreation Board minutes for September 6, 2020 were approved.

UPDATES:

501c3 Organization

“Friends of Adams Township Community Park, Inc.” has received many donations on behalf of Clay Morrow’s memorial. Haley Geyer informed the Board that there are five individuals available to serve on the Board and hope to have the first meeting scheduled before the end of the year.

Wygol Property

Haley Geyer informed the Board that the upgrades to the barn and house would be taking place in the month of November with the goal of closing on the property in Spring of 2021.

OLD BUSINESS:

Splash Pad Review & Discussion

Haley Geyer explained the planning and engineering process of the Splash Pad. The goal is to apply for a DCNR grant in the Spring of 2021 in hopes the Township gets awarded in the fall, so the project could be completed in Spring of 2022.

Pickleball Courts

Haley Geyer added that Pickleball Courts would be on her budget list for 2021. She visualizes to install 3-4 courts near the T-Ball Fields due to the area being close to existing parking and the restroom facility. She stated if we chose to add this amenity elsewhere, the project would take longer to complete and would become more expensive due to having additional parking and stormwater.
