MEC Industrial LLC (Formerly Harlan Simons)

Location is Dobson Road

Proposing consolidation and minor subdivision.

Shane Kaclik was present to represent MEC. He said this is a minor subdivision that currently has 4 lots and are proposing to subdivide into 6 lots. Mr. Kaclik stated that Mr. Olsen's comments have been addressed. Mr. McKinney said this seems to be a lot consolidation and creating new lots. Mr. Kaclik replied yes. Mr. Schultz questioned the reason for the additional lots. Mr. Kaclik stated there are potential buyers for the three lots and they are cleaning up the lot lines. Mr. Olsen stated he had no issues with the plan. Mr. Crouthamel who lives at 139 Pearce Road asked how many lots will be in the RC and Industrial District. Mr. Kaclik stated there will 4 lots in the RC and 2 lots in the in Industrial District. Mr. Peaco explained there was a Special Exemption hearing for this property to allow residential lots in the Industrial Zoning District.

On a motion by Marilyn Watson and seconded by Steve Madeja, MEC Industrial was given final approval.

Aldi Grocery Store

Location is Adams Corners.

Rory Garr was present to represent Aldi's Grocery Store. Mr. Garr said the store will be 22,000sq.ft. located east of the new traffic signal on Route 228 at Adams Corners. There was a discussion concerning lighting, landscaping, and façade materials. Mr. Garr stated this is the newest design for Aldi's and will have brick façade along with metal paneling.

Mr. Olsen discussed the need for a traffic study. Mr. Seth Geyer explained the Developers will bond a portion of the road to the South that will be used for truck deliveries. Mr. Mike Sutton who lives at 216 Horseshoe Drive questioned emergency vehicle access.
