

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the admission fee for the splash pad?

For general admission for our normal operating hours, we will not charge any fees to use the splash pad. Any special events added to the facility may require a fee to participate.

Do I have to pre-register before coming to the facility?

There is no reservation process for access to our splash pad. We leave the opportunity to create a registration process in the future but as for now, we will be open on a first come first served basis. If you are planning on attending the splash pad with a party of 10 or more people, you must receive approval from the Parks and Recreation Director at least 48 hours prior to your visit. Any special events added to the facility may require pre-registration to participate.

Do I have to be an Adams Township Resident to participate?

There are no restrictions based on residency, we will leave the opportunity to create a residency policy in the future but are not enforcing a policy in our first season.

Can I book a private rental?

Yes, we offer a private rental from 7:00pm-9:00pm which must be approved and paid in full 30 days prior to the event date. For information on renting the splash pad please contact the Adams Township Parks and Recreation Department. If you are planning on attending the splash pad with a party of 10 or more people, you must receive approval from the Parks and Recreation Director at least 48 hours prior to your visit.

Am I allowed to bring food and drink to the splash pad?

Food and drinks are allowed in the pavilion area, we ask that no alcoholic beverages are in the facility. Please do not bring glass or breakable bottles onto the turf.

Will there be township staff present during operating hours?

The facility will be staffed throughout the summer to manage operating hours. If the facility is open but not staffed, there will be signage to let guests know accordingly.

What if it rains?

Yes and no, depending on the forecast we will determine if we open, close, or have reduced operating hours. During operating hours, if there is lightning, the splash pad area will be evacuated for 30 minutes or more, before allowing guests back onto the turf or splash pad surface.
