### **Matilda Fields PRD Hearing Date**

Tim Stack, 240 Forsythe Road, asked what the timeline looks like on a PRD project? Mr. Stack stated that Matilda Fields was first brought to the Planning Commission meeting on April 3, 2024, and not a lot of information was given.

Chairman Ford stated that the Supervisors have not seen this plan and cannot speculate.

Mr. Stack asked when the clock starts for the process and hearing date.

Mr. Gallagher stated that the clock starts upon submission and then the project must go through the same process as all PRD's. First through Planning Commission to iron out all details then to Supervisors.

Larry Werner, 1124 Mars-Evans City Road, expressed concerns over potential future connection to his property.

Chairman Ford recommended Mr. Werner to attend Planning Commission meetings as the PRD has not made it to the Supervisors yet.

On a motion by Ronald G. Nacey and seconded by Darryl M. Brandon, the PRD hearing date for Matilda Fields was tabled. All were in favor.
