The regular meeting of the Adams Township Board of Supervisors was held on June 10, 2024 at 7:00 P.M. at the Adams Township Municipal Building, 690 Valencia Road, Adams Township, Mars, PA.

Present at the meeting were Supervisors Russell R. Ford, Ronald J. Shemela, David M. Goodworth, Ronald G. Nacey and Darryl M. Brandon; Solicitor Michael Gallagher, Township Manager Gary Peaco, Chief of Police Shawn Anglum, Park Director Brian Perry and Secretary Andrea Dunton.

Chairman Ford called the meeting to order at 7:11 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Simon Goehring, 336 Myoma Road, attended the meeting to express his concern regarding an Airbnb taking residence in a neighboring house. Mr. Geohring is concerned with his children being subject to random people being in and out in the neighborhood.

Chairman Ford asked the Township Solicitor to research what steps could be taken by the Township to avoid this and also requested that this be put on the Planning Commission agenda to be discussed. Mike Gallagher, Township Solicitor, stated that there are steps in zoning that could be put in place, but unfortunately the house that is already a working Airbnb will be grandfathered in since it occurred before any steps were taken.

Sue Stewart, 568 Route 228, attended the meeting to again voice her concerns regarding the PennDOT construction on 228, recently there were concrete barriers placed around her mailbox not allowing the Stewarts to receive their mail, there is no road sign as of yet for their road making it very confusing for deliveries and mail, and there is still an issue with their address change.

Chairman Ford stated that he drove past recently, and he agrees, it is horrible. Mr. Ford stated that he sympathizes, and he wishes the Board could do more. Since this is PennDOT project the Board has no jurisdiction. Mr. Ford again suggested that Ms. Stewart reaches out to her County and State Representatives to relay her concerns. Mr. Ford also stated that the Township can attempt to set a meeting with PennDOT representatives, two Supervisors, the Township Manager and the Stewarts in order to open the conversation for resolve.

Gene Montini, 110 Renee Dr., attended the meeting to express his concerns regarding the new stop signs on Myoma Rd. He stated that a representative in Public Works said the stop signs are for speed control. There are 3 stop signs and Mr. Montini is concerned that the placement is going to be problematic because of placement.

Mr. Montini also stated that he has a problem with developers doing their own traffic studies and wants to know if the existing houses are included in the study.

Chairman Ford asked if he has brought this concern to Planning Commission.

Mr. Montini stated he has.

Tim Stack, 240 Forsythe Road, stated that he would like to see date stamps and printed signatures on all RTK requested paperwork.

Mr. Stack also expressed concerns regarding the lights at the Centennial School stating that they are very bright.

Chairman Ford requested that Joe Julian, Assistant Code Enforcement Officer, drive by and evaluate.
