

ADAMS TOWNSHIP PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

The regular meeting of the Adams Township Parks and Recreation Board was held on May 5, 2026, at the Adams Township Municipal Building located at 690 Valencia Road, Mars, PA, 16046.

The meeting began at 6:00 P.M. The following members of the Parks and Recreation Board were present: Shelly Savoroski, Marilyn Watson, Heidi Brandon, Christine Sperdute and Rochelle Seideneck. Also present was the Parks & Recreation Director Brian Perry.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The committee approved the minutes of the April meeting, with a motion from Rochelle and Marilyn.

Public Comments: Tim Detisch 117 Cloverdale Dr. was present for public comment. He wanted to ask the parks board their thoughts on pickleball reservations, as well as programming for the courts. He also asked for cleaning tools like squeegees to be placed down on the courts.

OLD BUSINESS: Brian updated the board on the recent grant applications. We have received and planted 15 trees from the Bare Root Program. We received the local butler grant for 5 AED enclosures. We are still waiting to hear if we have received the Experience Butler County Grant that is for 8 sandwich board signs. Brian also updated the board on the Eagle Scout Gaga Ball Pit project. Evan will be completing the project in mid-June. Brian updated the board on the 250th event with updates on non-profits. He asked if you know any, reach out and see if they would like to attend. He also said that we have roughly 25 volunteers signed up, if you know anyone interested, please get them in contact with Brian. Lastly Brian updates the board on the splash pad prep. He has hired 8 staff for the summer, they are looking to add simple concessions to the facility, as well as still bring in local food trucks. The board also briefly discussed using the same hours of operations as in years past.

NEW BUSINESS: Brian brought to the board the idea of creating a specific special events application for large events to be used prior to being approved for use of the park. Brian will put together a draft, and we can discuss it at the next meeting. Brian also asked the group to look into finding a beneficiary for the fall car cruise.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 P.M. with a motion from Shelly, seconded by Marylin. The next meeting will be on June 2nd, 2026, at 6:00 P.M.
